### From Reverend Andy

Dear Friends,

Last year at this time we embarked on an art project called the "Before I Die" Wall. If you haven't been following our progress, likely the pictures will tell the story, there is also an article written about it in previous Parish Guide from last year and a news story from the Herald News (linked on our Facebook page).

It was up for about 10 months, and I'm really satisfied with its results. Nearly daily I would see people walk by and contemplate a hope in their life; reflect for a moment as they saw the hopes and dreams of others, some of them profound, some of them downright grotesque, but all of them recorded for a brief moment on our wall.

I'll likely write more on this in the future but this edition of the Parish Guide I simply wanted to share the journey in pictures over these last months. I can't thank enough everyone who helped build, maintain, watch over, and dissemble the wall: it's been a truly community project. I'm grateful to be a part of a community who was willing and excited to bring such a thing to life. I'm convinced that it brought a soulfulness to our little neighborhood and helped in small but real ways people to encounter themselves, and in doing so encounter God's call within them.

Lastly, as I reflect on these pictures and this journey; I'm struck by how truly this has been a journey through the Sublime and the Beautiful. Philosopher Edmund Burke 300 years ago captured these categories as the boundaries of human experience. On one end horror, awe, vastness, and terror in the sublime, and on the other joy, warmth, elegance, and majesty in the beautiful. He wrote, "Before the Christian religion had, as it were, humanized the idea of the divinity, and brought it somewhat nearer to us, there was very little said of the love of God." The Love of God comes to us through the incarnation of the Christ, through a Human Being, fully human and fully divine, fully sublime, and fully beautiful. It is the encounter with God's love for us that is nestled within the sublime and the beautiful of all our lives, between the crucifixion and the resurrection.

On our wall we had that, both the really whacky and terrible and the extremely beautiful and profound; both in 'bringing the divine nearer' brought us the Love of God. I muse on this because all of that big stuff that Burke mapped out played itself across our little wall full of chalk and paint. As we and our neighbors engaged our own mortality and answered the

question "Before I Die, I want to..." we saw, written in the hands of ourselves and others the very sublime and the beautiful brought to life in our humanity. And in THAT is the love of God in Christ Jesus.

I hope you enjoyed seeing this project, and maybe it disturbed you at times. I trust in that if it did, it was your own encounter with the sublime. I hope you spend some time taking a look at a years' worth of hopes and dreams, because they truly are sublime and beautiful.




