
#### Missions News!!

Autumn greetings First Congregational Church family! As referenced in recent Parish Guides we are once again participating in United Way's "United We Move" 2023-2024 annual campaign. If you enjoy foliage, crisp air and a leisurely walk this is a 1 mile path on the Tattapanum Trail in the Fall River Bioreserve. This year there is also a 5K trail (3.6 mi) if you really want to build some endurance! The date is Saturday October 21st with step off time to be confirmed (but usually around 9:00 AM). Missions will be making our annual donation via this event so get some fresh air and exercise and be in fellowship together to make our donation so much more meaningful. The "United We Move" campaign supports health, education, and financial stability/basic needs programs throughout Greater Fall River. On September 8 th in Fellowship Hall we enjoyed a great concert by Sandy Van Meristal, founder and director of Light A Candle Mission in the Dominican Republic. This mission helps Haitian migrants working in the sugar plantations in LaRomana. We thank all who attended and appreciate your generous donations to the open plate. We are continuing to support the Acoaxet Chapel's mission trip in February 2024 by participating in their clothing drive. Do some fall cleaning, fill a bag or a box, and bring it to FCC by October 13 (see items listed below). All donations go to Savers Thrift Store where it is weighed and exchanged for cash which funds flights and expenses for the mission's team. The Chapel holds their own separate drive for clothing, medicines and educational supplies to be given directly to the Haitian people. 
